RULES and REGULATIONS

Your kind cooperation and compliance to the below mentioned is critical to the well being of your students as well as the smooth implementation and coordination of the all various activities at the festival

1. Registration

Registration opens at 9.00am. Kindly bring along your School Reference ID. Only teachers/person-in-charge with 1 or 2 of their assistant(s) is allowed go to Information counters for registration so as to avoid congestion (Students are not allowed to enter reception area). During registration, teachers/person-in-charge will be given:

- a. Program Books
- b. Event T-shirt
- c. Event Certificates

After registration, teachers/person-in-charge is requested to bring their students to the directed venue for light breakfast.

2. Attire

All students **MUST** wear Event T-shirt or Yukata (hot pants; miniskirts; and sleeveless, see-through & tight clothing are **not permitted**). Students who are not in the above attire will not be allowed to participate in any activities of the event.

3. T-shirt size

5. Accompanying Teachers

All accompanying teachers are required to be with the students throughout the whole duration of the festival to ensure their safety and may be further requested to undertake certain duties during festival.

During the event, all accompany teachers make sure their students that they:
