

## The Japanese Language Proficiency Test – Dec 2025

### Notice to the Candidates in Malaysia

#### 1. The use of electronic devices

The use of electronic devices (such as hand phones, smart watches, smart glasses, earbuds, cameras, laptops, tablets, drones & etc) in the test room/hall and some designated common areas (such as toilets, staircase, corridor, lobby, etc) is strictly prohibited throughout the duration of the test.

Should candidates have to bring along their devices along, they may surrender their devices (at their own risk) to the proctors for safe keeping. Please note that any devices bigger than the size of a handphone will NOT be accepted. The surrendered devices will only be returned to the candidates at the end of the test (or when the candidate officially withdraw from the test) and not during breaks.

(For **Johor Bahru and Kota Kinabalu** test centre, candidates have to place their devices in a designated room before the test. The room will remain locked, and candidates may only collect them at the end of the test.)

The proctor, test administrators and its staff as well as the Japan Foundation is NOT liable to any damages to or loss of the devices under their care.

During the whole test period including BREAK TIME, candidates found

- using or touching their phones and electronic devices or
- going out to meet any outsiders (including family members and teachers) will be automatically disqualified.

#### 2. Test Vouchers

Candidate must bring along their test voucher. If they forget, they may get a replacement test voucher at the information counter for a fee.
